

ROLE: Elementary (grades 1-4) Small Group Leader (Sunday)

ROLE DESCRIPTION: Share the gospel and build relationships with a small group of children.

REASON: Small groups are critical for making disciples of the next generation.

REPORTS TO: Elementary Director

Our Mission: Building relationships, seeing Jesus transform lives.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Application
- Personal relationship with Christ
- Regular attendee
- Volunteer training

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Check email weekly and review lesson prior to Sunday.
- 2. Pray over lesson and children in your group. Ask for God's leading.
- 3. Arrive 15 minutes prior to the beginning of programming and be ready to greet children 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the hour.
- 4. Wear nametag.
- 5. Greet children by name as they arrive and have them sign the attendance sheet.
- 6. Review jewels and award the appropriate ones for the week.
- 7. Describe the "explore" activity and invite the children to participate.
- 8. At 5 minutes after the hour, gather your group and proceed to the large group teaching space.
- 9. Worship with your group through music, teaching, and response. Model for your kids with your own worship and response to God. Watch for distracting behaviors and remind kids of expectations.
- 10. Accompany children to the restroom if needed, remaining outside of the restroom.
- 11. After large group worship and teaching, return to your small group space and lead your group in review questions and an activity designed to reinforce what they learned during worship.
- 12. Pray with the children.
- 13. Remain with children until parents pick them up using proper checkout procedures as outlined in Volunteer Handbook.

REWARDS:

- 1. Satisfaction from influencing the next generation for God.
- 2. Use your gifts to help Calvary accomplish its mission: Building relationships, seeing Jesus transform lives.
