REQUIREMENTS:

- Application
- Personal relationship with Christ
- Regular attendee
- Volunteer training

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Check email weekly and review lesson prior to Wednesday.
2. Pray over lesson and children in your group. Ask for God's leading.
3. Attend the volunteer meeting at 6:10pm on Wednesday.
4. Pick up your nametag and your group bag.
5. Be in place and ready to greet your group in the Worship Center by 6:25pm.
6. Greet children by name as they arrive, noting their attendance on the attendance sheet.
7. Worship with your group through music and teaching. Model for your kids with your own worship and response to God. Watch for distracting behaviors and remind kids of expectations.
8. Accompany children to the restroom if needed, remaining outside of the restroom.
9. At 7:05pm transition your group to your meeting space. Lead children in small group discussion and activity.
10. Review memory verse and award prizes for weekly accomplishments (verse memorization, team shirt, and completed take home).
11. Pray with children.
12. Accompany your group to recreation time and engage with children during activity.
13. At 7:50pm, gather your group in the gym for dismissal. Hand out take-homes.
14. Check parent's security tag with child's nametag before releasing child. Remove nametag from child.

REWARDS:

1. Satisfaction from influencing the next generation for God.
2. Use your gifts to help Calvary accomplish its mission: Building relationships, seeing Jesus transform lives.
