REQUIREMENTS

- Christ Follower
- Regular attendee
- Application
- Background check (renewed every three years)

RECOMMENDED SPIRITUAL GIFTS

- Encouragement
- Leadership
- Shepherding

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Read weekly email for helpful info and updates.
- Serve alongside a class group, ideally for the duration of their time in Summit (three years).
- Be available Wednesday nights from 6-8pm for leader meeting and youth group.
- Contribute to a welcoming environment for students.
- Attend a minimum of one retreat during the year (but up to three are encouraged).
- Support programming as needed during Summit events (help behind the scenes, assist in planning, occasional lead upfront, etc.).
- Build meaningful relationships with students, regularly engage in contact ministry with a few consistent teenagers outside of programmed times. (Attend sporting events, write encouraging notes, get coffee/dinner, etc.).
- Work alongside a team of peers to create a sense of community within your class group.
- Using provided guides, lead student discussion on Wednesday nights and during retreats.
- Time commitment is 3 hours per week. (Additional time during retreats or other Summit events.)
